History

Founded in 1998, the Mennonite Children's Choir of Lancaster began as a choir of 31 members under artistic director Patricia Strong Myers. MCCL now offers five programs for over 150 children and youth in kindergarten through grade 12. Singers represent nearly 45 congregations, 40 schools, and 12 denominations. Weekly rehearsals during the school year prepare singers to present a Christmas and spring concert series. Annual local tour days and summer tour provide opportunity for personal growth and ministry. In addition, the choirs collaborate with arts organizations, participate in benefit concerts, and share music with schools and community organizations. MCCL is passionate about providing a place for young singers to thrive personally and musically as they learn to work together to create beautiful choral unity that blesses the community.
