Who is MCCL?

Children and youth in K - grade 12 representing:

- 55 congregations
- 45 schools from Lancaster and surrounding counties
- 12 denominations

Staff with dedicated passion to see children and youth equipped with choral excellence, leadership skills, team building skills, and spiritual growth all for the purpose of serving the broader community through music.

Families and singers committed to weekly rehearsals and at home practice for the purpose of individual and team musical growth, preparation for community concerts, and development of responsibility.



Choirs and Classes

Auditioned choirs rehearse Tuesday nights during the school year. Singers share three Christmas concerts in December and four to six concerts in the spring. Singers participate in local tour days inspiring the community with their music. The older two choirs experience a multi-day tour in June. Families support the choir through tuition, two annual fundraisers, and volunteer opportunities.

- Carol Choir grades 2 - 5
- Concert Choir grades 6 - 8
- Chamber Choir grades 9 - 12

Choral classes gather for eight weeks each semester. Singers share their music learning with families at the end of each semester and participate in a spring concert with the auditioned choirs. Families and parents support the choir through tuition and one fall fundraiser.

- Prelude Music kindergarten - grade 1
- Choristers I grades 2 - 5
- Choristers II grades 6 - 8

Tuition Assistance is available. MCCL works to ensure all children and youth can participate in choir.

Vision

We honor and celebrate music as a gift from God by creating exceptional choral music, fostering community, and nurturing character. We equip children and youth for a lifetime of worship and service to the church and community through Christ-centered repertoire that both affirms Anabaptist beliefs and reflects the musical diversity of the church around the world and across time.

Audition and Registration

Auditions for choirs are typically held in May and June. Registration for classes and choirs typically occurs in July.
